GOVERNING AND GENERAL BODY MEETING

- Discussions on updation, release of stagnation increments to the eligible 10th and 11th Bipartite retirees.

- Discussions on any issues related to pensioners of SBI and also of pensioners fraternity of Banking industry.

- Resolutions, if any, to be adopted.

The meeting is expected to deliberate on the issue of supply of medicines in the dispensaries run by the Bank and the related issues. It may also discuss the organisational activities in pursuance of the Pensioners and Family Pensioners demands at the industry level. The Federation also likely to deliberate on the status of the court cases filed to

resolve the issue of 50% of the last drawn pay as pension to all our retirees.

The Federation will also have an opportunity to debate on current situation in regard to our structured meeting with the management and the issues that are to be taken up on top priority basis with the management for consideration of the Bank.

The Federation representatives will also discuss the future cause of action of the organisation in resolving several long pending issues before IBA and Government such as the upgradation of pension, removal of anomaly in regard to Dearness Allowance etc..

The two day meeting will be concluded with the election of Federation office bearers for the term 2022-2025.

Let us wish both the meetings of the Federation all success.

She requested us to conduct 5 days Free Pranaayama camp to our Pensioners where she could teach all necessary pranaayamas to our members.

She also replied to our members queries satisfactorily.

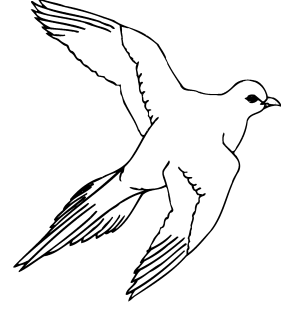

MEMBER WRITES....

I am M.K.Subramanya, membership No.3352. I joined the bank as a Clerk-typist at Jalahalli branch on 1.12.65 and took VRS on 31.3.2001. I refer to your note in the February issue of the magazine calling for information regarding any achievements of the members post retirement. I wanted to inform you suo motu even before your decision to call for this information but postponed as I was busy. During my service as award staff, I was relatively free and I had keen interest in specialising in legal field and joined LLB course in one of the evening colleges. It was very comfortable as the attendance was not compulsory. I did not attend the classes regularly but attended revision classes at the fag end of the year and passed the LLB examination in the late sixties. After retirement in 2001, I enrolled as Advocate with Bar Council and has been practicing as Advocate and presently I am an associate with NK Associates, Diamond District Apartments, Old Airport Road, Bangalore 560017. We deal with civil, criminal, real estate, Banking, Family Court cases etc. I was also a faculty for law subjects (Business and Commercial Law, Company Law and Income Tax Law) for Chartered Accountancy course. The students, who took coaching from me scored good marks and helped them to pass the examination. The minimum marks is 50 and there are 3 subjects in a group and there are two groups..Although the minimum marks are 50, a student scoring more than 40 in some subjects and scoring 60 or more in any subject, was entitled to set off of marks and could pass the examination. My students could score more than 60 in law and setting off surplus marks for the deficiency of marks in other subjects. Observing the students passing the examination, I decided to appear for the CA examination. I could pass in one group of the Inter by setting off high marks in Law but failed in the second group containing a subject titled Information Technology; because I cleared the first group, I

decided to study Information Technology paper in group II and cleared Inter examination in 2012. I have completed the final course but have not obtained Certificate of Practice as I am an Advocate and cannot be in both professions. While passing Law examination was a cackwalk, the CA course was very tough and required hard study. It is pertinent here to note that I was 68 when I passed CA Inter. With the study of CA, I became proficient in Income Tax, GST etc and help my clients in filing Income Tax and GST returns and also advise about Tax Planning. I consider the completion of the CA course as a great achievement as the examination is even tougher than UPSC (IAS) examinations. The CA institute will not give marks unless they are satisfied that the student is competent and knows the concepts clearly. CA also means 'Come Again' if the institute examiners are not happy with the answers.Christians say 'Jesus never fails' but I would say 'ask him to appear for CA examination and he will fail at least in his first attempt.

I along with my associate offer our services to all the members. The areas we cover are writing of Wills, succession, property matters, civil and criminal and any other field of law. I can help members in Income Tax, CapitalGains Tax if any of our members are selling the properties. I suggest the Magazine can start a legal and Income tax column to help our members to clear any doubts regarding law , Income tax etc. In case you do not intend to start a separate legal column, you can give my Email address to the members and they can clear any doubts on legal and Income tax matters.

I advise all members to write a Will which will help their legal heirs.to inherit the property comfortably after their demise. I will write a separate article giving more information on the need to make a Will.
