AMENDMENT IN STATE BANK OF INDIA EMPLOYEES' PENSION FUND REGULATIONS, 2014: COMPUTATION OF PENSION AT THE UNIFORM RATE OF 50% INSTEAD OF EXISTING 40%-50% CALCULATION

We are happy to inform our members that the Central Board of the Bank in its meeting held on 06.12.2023 has accorded approval for the amendments in Regulation 23 of the State Bank of India Employees' Pension Fund Regulations, 2014 regarding computation of pension for SBI retirees at the uniform rate of 50%.

Department of Financial services (GOI), vide its letter no. eF. No. 1/7/2022-IR dated 15th March, 2024 has conveyed the previous sanction of the Central Government, in terms of the provisions of Section 50 of the State Bank of India Act, 1955 to the said amendment in State Bank of India Employees' Pension Fund Regulations 2014.

Accordingly, Regulation 23 (2) of the State Bank of India Employees' Pension Fund Regulations, 2014 has been amended vide the State Bank of India Employees' Pension Fund (Amendment) Regulations, 2024 published in the Gazette of India on 20.03.2024. In terms of the said amendment, with effect from 10th November, 2023, notwithstanding the date of retirement or the Pay Scales in which the monthly substantive salary during the last twelve months'

pensionable service is drawn, the maximum amount of pension for the members who retired or retire shall be computed at the rate of fifty percent of the average of monthly substantive salary drawn during the last twelve months' pensionable service plus half of Professional Qualification Pay (PQP) plus half of increment component of Fixed Personal Pay (FPP), wherever applicable (pro-rata in the case of part-time employees).

The pension shall be computed and payable under the amended provision w.e.f. 10th November 2023 to all such pensioners who are otherwise entitled to pension under Regulation 22 of the State Bank of India Employees' Pension Fund Regulations, 2014.

As the amendment is made effective prospectively from 10th November 2023, the pensioners who had retired from the Bank's service prior to 10th November 2023 and are entitled to pension under Regulation 22 shall be paid pension under the amended provision w.e.f. 10th November 2023 and not from the date of their retirement.

EXTRACT OF GAZETTE NOTIFICATION DATED 20TH MARCH 2024

Provided also that with effect from the 10th November, 2023, notwithstanding the date of retirement or the Pay Scales in which the monthly substantive salary during the last twelve months' pensionable service is drawn, the maximum amount of pension for the members who retired or retire shall be computed at the rate of fifty per cent of the average of monthly substantive salary drawn during the last twelve months' pensionable service plus half of Professional Qualification Pay plus half of increment component of Fixed Personal Pay, wherever applicable (pro-rata in the case of part-time employees). Explanation. - The above proviso shall apply prospectively, and the pension shall be computed and payable under this proviso with effect from the 10th November, 2023.

Sub: Long unresolved issues of Bank Pensioners and Retirees.

We have been pursuing the under noted issues affecting the interest of Bank Pensioners and Retirees for a pretty long time. The normal grievance – redressal outlet for Bank Pensioners and Retirees is the Indian Banks' Association, Mumbai and the Department of Financial Services, MOF, GOI. We have made good number of correspondence and have undertaken follow up measures with both the authorities for effective resolution of our grievances.

As the issues are continuing to remain unresolved for a pretty long time, the pensioners and retirees of the Banking industry who are mostly in advanced age are feeling anguished at the fag end of their lives and hence the cause of appeal on our part arose. This may please be noted that CBPRO is a conglomerate of different organizations of Bank Retirees including the one of State Bank of India and a collective decision has been taken in the forum to approach your good self with the high hope of redressal of grievances.

We shall narrate in brief the principal cause of grievances which are commonly applicable to all the constituents of CBPRO:

1. UPDATION OF PENSION:

You are well aware of the fact that in the Bank Employees Pension Regulations (1995), there is a well laid down provision of pension updation spelt out in Appendix-1 of Regulation 35.1 which was subsequently amended in the year 2003 to make the clause universally applicable to all eligible Pensioners duly published in the gazette by Government of India. This is an established fact that the Pension Rules of Banks are modelled on the patterns of the same as applicable for Pensioners of GOI/RBI.

When the recommendations of the Pay Commission for existing Government Employees are implemented, the pension of each retired employee is also simultaneously upwardly revised at the time of each Pay Commission. The same thing happens in case of RBI/ NABARD Employees. Unfortunately, this concept of Updation is absent in the Banking Industry. Unlike the Govt./RBI/NABARD employees, in banking industry, the pension is fixed on the date of retirement and the basic pension amount remains unchanged till the death of the pensioners. IBA is under obligation to declare Pension Updation formula in respect of each Bipartite Settlement but instead of doing that, IBA is often taking a wrong plea and feeding the DFS with wrong information like "Banks' Pension Scheme is a funded one and there is no provision of Pension Updation in It. "

Records will reveal that the total amount held in the pension corpus of all Banks including SBI is Rs. 4 Lakh crores and the cost of Updation will be about Rs. 3000 crores only if the Pension Updation is done as per the RBI formula. This is because of the fact that the benefits arising out of the 100 Percent DA Neutralization is already passed on to Pre-November 2002, Pensioners. The Banks do not need to make any further provisions for Updation on that count. We are sure that the existing Corpus is sufficient to manage the burden arising out of Pension Updation. The astronomical figure, reportedly quoted by IBA, is absolutely wrong without any scientific basis. The Banks have also been making very high Operating Profits throughout and also huge Net Profits in spite of NPA Provisions.

It is beyond comprehension that the benefit of Updation which is already provided in Bank Employees Pension Regulation and Settlement is being held back illegally with the allurements of Ex-gratia to the hapless Pensioners thus exploiting their emotional vulnerability.

We earnestly request that IBA may please be advised to render justice to all Pensioners of Banking Industry, by notifying the Formulae for Updation of Pension as done for RBI and NABARD Pensioners.

2. RECKONING OF SPECIAL ALLOWANCE TO COMPUTE PENSION & GRATUITY: -

A special allowance was introduced for all the officers and employees of the Banks w.e.f.01.11.2012 (10th Bipartite Wage Settlement & 7th Joint Note) by reducing the basic pay by 7.50%, which is being paid as a "special allowance". It attracts Dearness Allowance. It is not linked to any incentive formula and is paid across the board to all employees even when they are on leave. The said features of the "special allowance" makes it accountable for superannuation benefit as adjudged by the Hon'ble Supreme Court on 28.02.2019 in the matter of the Regional Provident Fund Commissioner (II) West Bengal versus Vivekananda Vidyamandir and ors. In the backdrop of this judgment, a case was lodged in the High Court of Kerala at Ernakulam praying for a similar relief as adjudged by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. The single bench has given a judgment favourable to the pensioners but the order of the single bench has been challenged by the bank as per advice of IBA and the issue is now pending with the Division Bench. In the meantime, the allowance, which at the time of introduction was only 7.5% of the basic pay has now gone up to 26.5% of basic pay through subsequent wage settlements including one that has been signed on 8th March, 2024 between IBA and constituent unions of UFBU. Your good self must appreciate the tune of loss the Bankmen are sustaining in their pension amount and in SBI in P.F. as well as they enjoy benefit of a contributory Provident Fund Scheme. We would pray to your good self to impress upon IBA to restrain themselves from dragging the issue and instead obey the said order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court keeping in mind the earlier verdict of the Hon'ble Supreme Court, which only vindicates the prayer of the pensioners.

3. CONSULTATION/NEGOTIATION STATUS TO THE APEX ORGANISATIONS OF THE PENSIONERS: -

The Bank Pensioners' number far exceeds the serving employees and officers at more than 7.60 Lakh pensioners. But our grievances are still left at the mercy of IBA and serving Bank Officers and Employees Organizations. Our repeated requests for consultative/negotiating status at IBA level are obstructed by IBA on the ground that the Banks have authorized the IBA to have dialogue with UFBU leaders only and not the retiree organizations. Sir, you are aware of the fact the Boards of the banks take such Resolutions at the advice of the Management Committee of IBA. If the advice is given to talk to apex level Bank Pensioners and Retirees Organizations on matters relating to Pensioners, then Banks will follow the same. Moreover, IBA has issued an advisory to all member banks to form a grievance redressal forum for pensioners at the corporate level of each bank but strangely enough IBA does not follow the same in the letter and spirit of its own guidelines at its own level. We demand that the apex level retiree organizations should be given a formal consultative status at IBA level to discuss matters relating to pensioners and retirees.

Payment of Pension as per new Regulation.

It is historic that now onwards the employees/pensioners of State Bank of India will be receiving pension at the rate of fifty percent of the average of monthly substantive salary drawn during the last twelve months' pensionable service plus half of Professional Qualification Pay plus half of increment component of fixed Personal Pay, irrespective of their rank and pay. This could be achieved by our Federation with the fullest support of our management and we once again express our sincere gratitude for the empathy shown to the cause of the pensioners who have been receiving a pension lesser than their peers in other Banks.

We are also thankful to all the functionaries under your able stewardship, who toiled much to ensure payment of revised pension from the month of March 2024. Although a sizeable number of beneficiaries are yet to receive the benefit but the concerned functionaries deserve appreciation for the endeavour they made for an expeditious payment.

In this connection, we have to draw attention of your good self that the revised formula has brought in an extra benefit for Seventh Bipartite retirees among the beneficiaries as PQP and FPP were not taken into consideration when they were sanctioned their rightful demand by the Murmu Committee.

In this connection, to ensure justice for other retirees of Seventh bipartite wage settlement, who are not beneficiary of the present escalation of pension, i.e. the entire award staff retirees and the JMGS1 in supervising cadre, calculation of the pension after inclusion of half of Professional Qualification Pay plus half of increment component of Fixed Personal Pay is need of the hour and, accordingly we would pray for the same. Probably your good self is aware that since the implementation of Murmu Committee Report by the Bank we are requesting for inclusion of these two allowances while computing pension. Now as a group of the Seventh Bipartite retirees have been favoured with the inclusion of those allowances in their pension calculation, we would once again pray to extend similar benefit to the other group of Seventh Bipartite retirees, which consist of JMGS1, clerical and subordinate cadre.

PENSION COMPUTATION AT THE UNIFORM RATE OF 50% W.E.F 10.11.2023 FAMILY PENSION AT 30% OF LAST DRAWN PAY W.E.F 01.04.2021

With reference to the captioned subject, we advise that the Competent Authority vide Note no. HR/P&PMD/SP/2023-24/299 dated 19.01.2024 has approved the formula for uniform computation of Pension @50% for all the eligible SBI pensioners and eAB employees who have opted for SBI Option (Officers as well as Award Staff), as under.

- Award Staff: Average monthly substantive salary drawn during last 12 months' consisting of Basic pay, Special pay, PQP and increment component of FPP. (Maximum 50%)
- Supervising Staff: Average monthly substantive salary drawn during last 12 months' consisting of Basic pay, PQP and increment component of FPP. (Maximum 50%)

2. Further, as per the e-Circular No. CDO/P&HRD-PPFG/63/2021-22 dated 03.11.2021, revision of family pension at the rate of 30% of 'Applicable Pay for the deceased employees / pensioners was implemented w.e.f. 01.04.2021. We advise that Competent Authority vide note no. HR/P&PMD/PJ/2022-23/268 dated 27.01.2023 has approved that 'Applicable Pay' is 'Last Drawn Pay' for computation of family pension at a uniform rate of 30% of Last Drawn Pay w.e.f 01.04.2021.

3. For all other terms & conditions please refer the respective Regulations / Circulars.

PAYMENT OF EX-GRATIA

We understand there is a growing agony in the minds of our members for the delay in payment or ex-gratia payable as per 12th Bipartite/8th Joint Note. We have already advised that a sizeable number of pensioners eligible for enhanced amount of pension could not be included in last month's exercise and some more number of pensioners, the 7th bipartite retirees, have been found eligible for enhancement after adding PQP and FPA as per our long-lasting demand. The bank is trying hard to accommodate all the beneficiaries of the abolition of the 40:50 imbalance during this month's pension disbursement. This is a priority for the Bank as the Bank has to report back to the Court about compliance of Govt. order on the next date of hearing scheduled on 2nd May 2024.

The above is one reason for the delay in payment of ex-gratia. Secondly, as already shared with our affiliates/members, vide our letter No. 79/73-24 dated 15.03.2024, we urged upon the Bank to calculate the ex-gratia on notional calculation of pension at the rate of 50% as on 31.10.2022 for those who were being paid less than the amount, else those pensioners will get an inferior amount to their peers in other Banks who were getting 50% of last pay as pension on the effective date of ex-gratia, i.e. 01.11.2022. As the Bank has found reason in our submission, the same has been forwarded to the IBA for their clearance, which is yet to be responded to. We are waiting with our fingers crossed but with a hope in our minds for a positive response.

We hope that rank and file will appreciate the reason for delay in payment of ex-gratia and maintain restraint for some time further to ensure similarity in benefit for all.

KEEP AWAY FROM PROPAGANDISTS

We are watching with utter dismay that some of our members have been sharing texts released from time to time the one Shri Umesh Sharma on behalf of so-called GOP (group of pensioners) in different WhatsApp groups formed by our units without knowing that the so-called GOP is not of a representative character and that they have gone to the Delhi High Court in 2016, much later to our Federation, as we submitted our petition at the Supreme Court of India for adjudication in the year 2011, which was subsequently transferred to the High Court in Delhi in 2013. Further, if anybody goes through the proceedings of each hearing, he/she will find that the advocate engaged by the GOP seldom spoke, mostly he remained silent spectator of the proceedings. The presence is so negligible that the Court did not ask them to submit any representation to the DFS. The order dated 13th April 2023 to submit a representation to DFS for consideration by a Committee was aimed at to our Federation only providing us an opportunity to speak before the Committee, first ever opportunity offered to any

organization of Pensioners in the banking industry, and through our deliberation before the Committee we could establish that 40:50 imbalance is an 'anomaly'. Resultantly, new era of 50% for all has ushered in for the pensioners/employees of State Bank of India.

Now as the credit of this achievement glorifies solely the Federation of SBI Pensioners' Associations, Shri Sharma is circulating texts showing his keenness to achieve retrospective effect of the gain to constantly remain in the focus of attention.

As in our previous communications, once again we iterate that our prayer before the court is for 50 per cent of last pay as pension for all, cutting across cadre and pay divide, from the date of one's retirement, and we have no reason to accept anything less than that. When on 22.01.2024 Addl. Solicitor General apprised the court about the decision of government to abolish the 40 : 50 divide in payment of pension in State Bank of India and prayed for closure of the case as the

same has virtually become in fructuous, our advocate strongly objected to that saying we will prefer adjudication on our prayer as we could gather that the payment will be made prospectively, while our prayer is for retrospective payment, i.e. from the date of one's retirement. Resultantly, a new date has been fixed on the 2nd May 2024, so that we and the court as well can take a clear view after actual compliance of the order of the Government.

Friends! We are waiting for a judicial disposal on our prayer and our Governing Body has already taken a decision in its meeting held on 19.01.2024 at Thiruvananthapuram, that in the event the court upholds the decision of the Government for payment of the enhanced pension from a prospective date, the Federation will again appear before the Apex court for justice.

It will not be out of point to mention that only through court case our Federation could raise maximum pension from Rs. 1,000/- to Rs. 2,400/- and could bring in Family Pension in State Bank of India in the year 1979. Again through the present case we could bring justice for 5th to 7th bipartite retirees and now the abolition of 40 : 50 divide among retirees of State Bank of India.

Incidentally, this achievement will not only bring substantive financial benefit to the existing pensioners but all the serving employees who joined the Bank prior to emergence of the New Pension Scheme as well.

Now onwards, our fight will be to ensure enhanced pension from date of retirement and inclusion of FPP and PQA in the pension for all the 7th bipartite retirees.

Friends! I have faith in your organization, take pride of its achievements and don't get confused on the false propaganda being spearheaded by persons like Shri Umesh Sharma (GOP) himself as the sole saviour of the pensioners in SB1.

WHO ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR BENEFIT ON SBI 40% - 50% CASE

Pensioners all over Country are eagerly waiting for the implementation of single ceiling on pension at 50% of last drawn 'Pay' for all SBI employees. Presently, 83% of the pensioners are already drawing 50% of their last 'Pay' as pension and only 17% of the pensioners (at senior level) are drawing at 40% of their last 'Pay' as pension.

We are receiving numerous enquiries from many pensioners, particularly who are already drawing 50% of their last 'Pay' as pension, whether they will get any benefit on implementation of single ceiling of 50% on pension. In this connection, to provide clarity, we furnish below the details with regard to Pensioners, who are not eligible for benefit on SBI 40% - 50% Case (as they are already drawing 50% of their last 'Pay' as pension):

Who are not eligible for benefit on SBI 40% - 50% Case?

1. All retired employees belonging to Subordinate Cadre;
2. All retired employees belonging to Clerical Cadre;
3. All retired employees belonging to Supervisory Cadre JMGS-I;
4. All retired employees belonging to Supervisory Cadre in other grades such as

REVISED PENSION @ 50%

We understand from posts shared by some of our members in different WhatsApp groups that they have received pension as in February 2024 and there is no change although they are eligible (retired in the maximum of MMGS-II) as they have been getting pension less than 50% of their last pay.

We have already taken up with Corporate Centre about this anomaly and could gather that this might have caused due to incorrect data in HRMS portal. We have been advised to request all such eligible pensioners to mail to concerned AGM PPG at each LHO about their status at the time of retirement alongwith P.F No. keeping Circle Association in the loop for redressal.

We will remain in constant touch with Corporate Centre till every eligible pensioner receives his/her due.

REALTY VS. CONFUSION / MYTH

There is some confusion in the minds of few people that achieving 50% pension of last drawn basic pay is due to efforts made by few individuals. Perhaps they are not aware or deliberately hiding the fact that the Pensioners' Federation approached the Supreme Court in the Year 2011 against this injustice but after 2 years Hon'ble Supreme Court sent the case to the Delhi High Court for adjudication in 2013. The views of events are as under

- 2 2011- Federation filed the case in SC for removal of the 40%-50% anomaly.
- 3 2013- Case Transferred to Delhi High Court on the plea of GOI Counsel that case should have been first filed in the High Court.
- 4 2016- Govt. appointed Murmu Committee and sought adjournment pending outcome of the committee. – Realignment of pension of 5th, 6th & 7th Bipartite as per salary structure. Federation refused to present their view and be a part of the same.
- 5 2019- Hearing of the case was almost over from Federation side bench was also favorable but few individual sought time for their presentation – Bench changed due to retirement of the Judge. Corona further delayed the process.
- 6 2023-GOI Counsel presented if Federation make representation afresh it may be considered by the DFS.
- 7 Though, prior to present Chairman, other top functionaries of the Bank including Mrs. Arundhati Bhattacharya, the then Chairman also made efforts to remove this anomaly and recommended before DFS to give their nod for 50% pension to all but issue could not be clinched. Noteworthy that Federation leadership was also asked to present their case of 50% before Chairman & other top executives, which pave the way for recommendation to DFS. In between, few individuals also filed writ petitions to remove this disparity but ultimately all the writ petitions were clubbed with Federation writ petition and was being heard together.
- 8 After number of arguments / change of judges as well as change of lawyer's at High Court, ultimately efforts of Federation yielded some results. A committee of DFS officials was formed and the committee asked the Bank, the Pensioners' Federation and all India State Bank Officers Federation to put their case before them. As Bank was already agreed to pay 50% pension to all, this was again reaffirmed by the then DMD & CDO

before the committee. From the side of Pensioners' Federation, President and General Secretary placed detailed submissions with valid reasons for their cause of 50% and lastly AISBOF was represented by the President Com. Rupam Roy, General Secretary Com. Deepak Sharma but the submissions on their behalf were made by Com. G D Nadaf, Ex. Director of the Bank & former General Secretary of AIBOC / AISBOF who presented in detail the genesis of pension system in SBI and entire history of pension regulations and unitalaral decision of SBI Management to introduce 40% - 50% formula. After these deliberation, the committee members were convinced and agreed that 40% - 50% was an anomaly and ultimately the additional solicitor General, Govt. of India, apprised the Court about findings of the committee as the empowered committee accepted the anomaly and the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi directed SBI Management to make amendments to relevant regulations as per section 50 of SBI act 1955 and also directed them to put up compliance report by the 22nd May 2024.

- 9 Though many individuals are also contesting the case initiated by Late Sri P P R Upadhyay, Retired General Manager and others, but these cases are in their individual capacity and as such might not be applicable to entire lot of beneficiaries. Do not confuse with various social media posts by different individuals and so called other organizations and remain assured that Federation will fight the battle to its logical end.
- 10 Fight is still not over and entire Federation is determined to achieve its logical demand for 50% pension with retrospective effect to all eligible pensioners as resolved in last Executive Committee meeting and ultimate goal is to clinch pension updation. Friends, individuals may come and go but organization will always remain there and clinch the goals set by the members.
- 11 However, not only Pensioners' Federation but every individual member deserves applause and appreciation alongwith Bank's top management, officials of DFS and last but not the least Finance Minister Mrs. Nirmala Sitaraman, without her intervention it was not possible.

COURT NEWS

First of all I would like to congratulate each one of you who have stood behind our Pensioners Association like a solid rock. As all of you know that many issues of Pensioners has taken a long time to see the light of the day. One of them being the Anomaly of fixing Basic Pension at the rate of 50% to all the retirees from 7th bipartite settlement onwards, due to which a number of our Pensioners suffered. The matter was taken to the Court by our Federation in 2011 to the Supreme court and later on as per their direction the appeal was filed in Delhi High court in 2013(O.S.No.1875/2013) which we feel that all of you are well conversant.

Our Fight in the court has been acknowledged and the Honourable Delhi High Court directed to our Bank to rectify the anomaly (after due hearing of our grievance from our Federation leaders and Leaders of the Officers Federation by the Committee formed for this purpose.) The anomaly has since been rectified by our Bank and new Pension Basic has been paid (in some cases to be paid) along with arrears prospectively from 10th November2023. The bank has been directed by the court to confirm the action taken on 02/05/2024.

Friends our federation has incurred huge expenditure behind this case which will be continued by them for getting Basic pension fixation from retrospective effect, which once again involves lot of expenditure.
