POSITIVE DEVELOPMENTS

SBI Pensioners fraternity are happy about some of the positive developments that have taken place since last few months, on the long pending issues and continued struggle.

Our members might have observed that Hon.Finance Minister Mrs.Nirmala Sitaraman has recently appreciated the achievements of SBI, in the Lok Sabha.

Besides this, important development that took place is that the bi-partite talks for next wage revision settlement formally began on 28th July, 2023 between IBA and UFBU. IBA has formed the main Negotiating Committee as well as sub-committees to discuss the demands, which will continue in the next round of talks. Meanwhile they have signed the minutes of the Meeting on 28th July 2023 for extending 100% D.A for pre November, 2002 Pensioners and Family Pensioners. It will be appreciated that this is a very significant development which will bring all Pensioners and Family Pensioners on equal Platform in respect of DA Compensation. Government clearance is awaited.

Court Case at High Court in Delhi Anomaly in Dearness Allowance is gone.

We have already advised, while proceedings of our case No. 1875/2013 in Delhi High Court resumed on 31. July 2023, the Govt. Counsel sought 8 weeks time to obtain view of the IBA. Even after strong objection by our Advocate, the court decided (a) Petitioners/Federation should be invited for hearing by the Committee before submitting the report. Three members from the Federation can be present but only one of them should present their case, (b) case to come on 06.10.2023.

We are, however, glad that the discrepancy in payment of Dearness Allowance between pre and post Nov. 2022 retirees, which was included as one of the grievances in our Memorandum submitted to the DFS and which was made an item in the agenda before the empowered committee has now been done away with through an Agreement between IBA and UFBU, though the same was not in the agenda item of the meeting slated and held on the 28th July 2023. Presumably, the IBA representative in the Committee could get the nod from DFS in this regard. This is a favourable decision for those who had been suffering financial loss and one of the main three issues we have been pursuing for a considerable period and with the issue of family pension since resolved, our remaining issue at industry level is only the Updation of Pension. We hope that Committee will not hesitate to issue certain direction to IBA and this lone grievance will be solved alongwith the ensuing wage settlement at industry level. At State Bank level we have 40:50 disbalance to be resolved, which is the remaining issue of our plaint before the court. We are confident we will be able to convince the Committee about genuineness of our grievance and the same will be settled by the court of law in due course.

BRIEF REPORT OF GB/AGM OF THE FEDERATION OF SBI PENSIONERS' ASSOCIATION HELD ON 16TH AND 17TH AUGUST 2023 AT AHMEDABAD.

The Governing Body and Annual General Body Meeting of our Federation was held at SBILD, (Gandhinagar), Ahmedabad Gujarat on 16th and 17th August 2023.

The two days' meeting discussed on all the major issues confronted by SBI Pensioners in particular and Bank Retirees in General. The meetings presided over by Sri. G K Gandhi Federation President, was attended by leaders from all the affiliates of the Federation.

The meeting appreciated the signing of minutes with regard to 100 percent neutralization of DA by, UFBU with IBA for pre 2002 retirees . Sri. Deepak Kumar Basu, Federation General Secretary also shared with the participants, on the proceedings of the meeting of Federation leaders with DFS officials held in New Delhi on 9th August 2023 in compliance of Hon'ble Delhi HC order of 31/7/23 in respect of Restoration of 50% pension for all officers in SBI and expressed satisfaction that the issue in detail has been convincingly presented before DFS and a positive outcome in the issue is expected shortly.

Among other things discussed in the meeting were on Updation of pension, difficulties suffered by members in e-Pharmacy scheme, nomination facilities in respect of LTA and for Disabled Children for Family Pension. President Shri G.K.Gandhi informed that the Federations were yet to decide on what type of Updation/upgradation/revision, like whether it should be RBI formula or LIC formula or Pay commission formula is to be demanded and discussed.

We are extremely happy that a Resolution to discontinue the prevailing arrangement with Medibuddy and Tata 1 mg due to their totally indifferent attitude and the difficulties suffered by many, and to entrust the same to some other providers, was unanimously approved in the GB and AGM and decided to forward it to the Corporate centre.

There was a general opinion that circles were facing shortage of medicines at the dispensaries due to non revision of stocking pattern ,which at present is based on a circular issued by CC in the year 2009. The entire GB was the opinion that there was a need to stock adequate medicines and open new Dispensaries, appoint Doctors,

and Pharmacist and requested the Federation GS to take up the matter with Corporate Centre.

It was also brought to the notice of the house regarding the less pension received by many of those retired as subordinate staff who served as part-time employees in SBI. Whereas the E -Associate retirees are ensured minimum pension by way of the recently sanctioned ex-gratia, the subordinate staff retirees in SBI are still drawing very meagre pension without any ex-gratia benefits.

We are indeed happy that the new CGM HR Corporate Center .Sri. Rajeev Kumar, who assumed charge a month back addressed the GB meeting and shared the latest information that the *Samadhan Pakhwada* introduced by the Bank on 12th May 2023 proved to be very helpful in resolving the issues of Pensioners and as a result Bank has decided to conduct it as an ongoing programme in every quarter hereafter. The next Programme will be held during September 2023. He also requested to extend wholehearted support in updating the HRMS data of Pensioners which will be base for issuing New PPO's, Renewal of Policy B, etc. and smooth conduct of Samadhan Pakhwada .

The AGM held on 17th August was a well conducted one in which CGM, CDO Ahmedabad LHO, General Secretaries and Presidents of Officers Association, Staff Union and Sewa participated and were also of the opinion that there was a need for revision of Pension, and assured all the support in this regard.

All the dignitaries who were on the dais were felicitated by the President and General Secretary of the Pensioners Federation. Before concluding the meeting all the affiliates wholeheartedly thanked and congratulated the Host Affiliate SBIPA AHMEDABAD CIRCLE led by Shri Ramesh Choksi President and Shri Kamal Kadri General Secretary and their entire team for making the GB and AGM a grand success. The meeting ended with National Anthem.

AADHAR CARD LINK WITH PAN CARD

HOW CAN I KNOW MY AADHAR CARD LINKED WITH PAN CARD?

Here's How To Check The Status Of The Aadhaar-PAN Card Link Online.

1. Visit the Income Tax Department's official website - incometax.gov.in/iec/foportal/
2. Open the Quick Links section and select Link Aadhaar Status.
3. Enter your PAN and Aadhaar Card number.
4. Click on the 'View Link Aadhaar Status' option.

HOW CAN I LINK MY AADHAAR WITH PAN CARD ONLINE?

Step 1: Go to e-filing Portal > Login > On Dashboard, in Profile section under the Link Aadhaar to PAN option, click Link Aadhaar. Or alternatively, click on Link Aadhaar in personal details section. Step 2: Enter the Aadhaar number and click on Validate.

DO WE NEED TO LINK PAN CARD WITH AADHAR CARD?

It is mandatory to link Aadhaar with PAN card because your PAN will become inoperative if your Aadhaar is not linked with PAN. Also, if you have to carry out a banking transaction above Rs. 50,000, you have to get your PAN card and Aadhar card linked.

HOW CAN I CHECK MY AADHAAR AND PAN IS LINKED THROUGH SMS?

How To Check PAN-Aadhaar Link Through SMS?

1. Step 1: Click on the messaging app on your phone.
2. Step 2: Create a new message and type 'UIDPAN <12 Digit Aadhaar Number><10 Digit PAN Number>
3. Step 3: Send this message to 56161 or 567678.

WHY PAN IS LINKED TO AADHAR?

It has become a mandatory process to link your PAN with Aadhaar. This is an important process because this will allow your income tax returns to be processed.

PRE 1986 RETIREES / SURVIVING SPOUSES OF PRE 1986 RETIREES PAYMENT OF ADDITIONAL EX-GRATIA

In terms of GOI letter no. F. No. 11/2/2012-IR dated 17.12.2013, a fixed lumpsum amount and Dearness Relief (DR) thereon is being paid to Pre 1986 retirees / surviving spouses of other PSBs and e-ABs (Now SBI).

2. After merger of Associate Banks with State Bank of India, the payment of ex-gratia to pre 1986 retirees / surviving spouses of e-ABs is being done by respective LHOs by debiting bank's Charges Account. The present ex-gratia amount payable to pre-1986 retirees / surviving spouses of pre-1986 retirees are as under:

3. Indian Banks' Association (IBA) vide its letter no. HR&IR/MBRT743/2022-23/11722 dated 07.02.2023 has advised the banks to consider additional ex-gratia payment over and above the amount being paid to ensure that the surviving pre-1986 retirees / surviving spouses of pre-1986 retirees get a minimum of Rs. 10,000/- per month as Ex-gratia. Accordingly, the Executive Committee of Central Board in its meeting held on 13.06.2023 has approved the payment of additional Ex-Gratia of Rs.550/- p.m. (Fixed) to both pre-1986 retirees and surviving spouses of pre-1986 retirees. This additional ex-gratia amount will attract Dearness Relief at the same rate as applicable to ex-gratia amount. The revised payment including additional ex-gratia to pre-1986 retirees and surviving spouses of pre-1986 retirees will be as under:

ASSISTANCE TO RETIRED EMPLOYEES IN CASE OF CRITICAL ILLNESS REVIEW

Please refer to our e-circular No. CDO/P&HRD-IR/107/2017-18 dated 21/03/2018, wherein the details of the captioned scheme have been advised.

2 The scheme has been reviewed by the competent authority and with a view to further rationalize, simplify and improve the scheme for the benefit of our retired employees, the following changes/modifications are being made:

b)	For retirees covered under REMBS Scheme: The assistance is provided to the extent of 50% of the eligible medical expenses incurred over and above the amount paid under the medical scheme/ insurance policy. The maximum assistance is Rs.5.00 lacs per retiree, per annum (including spouse)	For retirees covered under REMBS Scheme: The assistance will be provided to the extent of 100% of the eligible medical expenses incurred over and above the amount paid under the medical scheme/insurance policy. The maximum assistance will be Rs.7.00 lacs in a year per person (i.e. Husband and Wife)
c)	For retirees not covered under REMBS Scheme: The Bank deducts Rs. 3.00 lacs and then provide assistance to the extent of 50% of the remaining eligible medical expenses. The maximum assistance is Rs. Rs.5.00 lacs per retiree, per annum (including spouse)	For retirees not covered under REMBS Scheme: The Bank will deduct Rs. 3.00 lacs and then provide assistance to the extent of 100% of the remaining eligible medical expenses. The maximum assistance will be Rs.7.00 lacs in a year per person (i.e. Husband and Wife)

- d) The coverage of this welfare scheme is applicable only for medical treatment involving hospitalisation. Medical expenses incurred on domiciliary treatment are not covered under this scheme.
- e) The structure of the 3-member Committee for examining /approving/ rejecting the proposals will be - General Manager (OL & CS), Deputy General Manager (IR) and Chief Medical Officer. In the absence of any of the above officials, their relief arrangements will attend the meeting.
- f) The Committee meeting will continue to take place at monthly intervals whenever claim applications are available.
- g) All the applications, whether approved or declined, will be returned to the respective Administrative Offices, who will return only the rejected applications to the applicant on the recorded address and keep the approved applications in their records.
- h) A few changes have also been made in the format of the documents to be submitted alongwith the proposal. The revised formats are placed as Annexure.

RBI launches उद्गम - UDGAM - Centralised Web Portal for searching Unclaimed Deposits

The Governor, Reserve Bank of India today launched a Centralised Web Portal उद्गम UDGAM (Unclaimed Deposits – Gateway to Access inforMation). This portal has been developed by RBI for use by members of public to facilitate and make it easier for them to search their unclaimed deposits across multiple banks at one place.

The Reserve Bank of India had announced the development of a centralised web portal for searching unclaimed deposits as part of the Statement on Developmental and Regulatory Policies dated April 06, 2023. Given the increasing trend in the amount of unclaimed deposits, RBI has been undertaking public awareness campaigns from time to time to sensitise the public on this matter. Further, through these initiatives, the RBI has been encouraging members of public to identify and approach their respective banks for claiming unclaimed deposits.

The launch of the web portal will aid users to identify their unclaimed deposits/ accounts and enable them to either claim the deposit amount or make their deposit accounts operative at their respective banks. Reserve Bank Information Technology Pvt Ltd (ReBIT), Indian Financial Technology & Allied Services (IFTAS) and participating banks have collaborated on developing the portal.

To begin with, users would be able to access the details of their unclaimed deposits in respect of seven banks presently available on the portal. The search facility for remaining banks on the portal would be made available in a phased manner by October 15, 2023.
