## REPORT OF THE 40TH ANNUAL GENERAL BODY MEETING OF SBIPA(K) HELD ON 21/12/2024 AT BANGALORE.

### INAUGURAL SESSION:

The inaugural session commenced at 10.00 A.M. with Smt. Renuka Desai welcoming our Members and requesting the huge gathering who were outside the hall to occupy the vacant seats. The session commenced with Invocation prayer by Shri Dattatreya Vantamuri, Smt. Vijaylakshmi, and Shri H.G.Sridhar followed by inviting SBIPA(K) President Shri T.Ramesh Rao, and General Secretary Shri A.L.Ramaswamy Rao, Shri Sushil Kumar Singh, General Manager, Network-I, Shri Dipak Kumar Basu, General Secretary, Federation of SBI Pensioners Associations, Shri Rajesh Chourey, DGM & CDO, Shri M.Ravikumar, General Secretary SBSU(K), Shri Parashuram, DGS(HQ) SEWA, and Shri M.G. Venkatesha Murthy, Senior Vice President, FSBIPA on to the stage.

The function was inaugurated with Lighting the Lamp By Shri Sushil Kumar Singh, GM Network-I and other dignitaries who were on the dias.

President of SBIPA(K) Shri T Ramesh Rao welcomed all the dignitaries on the Dias, members, their families to the AGM. He explained about the activities of the Association, support extended by our Management in resolving the issues in brief. He also appealed to the General Secretary of our Federation about the pending issues relating to SBI Pensioners. Request was also made to the Management Functionaries to provide a bigger space for association office due to increase in number of members. He also congratulated the members who completed 90 years and above on this occasion. He also conveyed his best wishes to the officials to be honoured at LHO with Chairman/CGM club awards on the same day evening. He also thanked the members who paid Donations at a call of the association on account of arrears of pension received due to rectification of

40-50 percent anomaly while fixing the Basic Pension, Payment of Exgratia on account of 12th BPS/9th Joint Note understanding. He also informed the house that a sum of Rs.5.00 lacs has been paid to the Federation towards legal fund.

Shri Sushil Kumar Singh, GM Network-I in his inaugural address explained in detail about the business of Bangalore Circle. He also praised the pensioners for playing the role of Brand Ambassadors of SBI. He also expressed his happiness and said that he was overwhelmed to see such a huge gathering of Seniors and conveyed his best wishes to all and assured that the circle management will always be with the pensioner in resolving their issues. He also appealed to help the circle in improving the CASA deposits which has fallen below 40%.

In his address Shri Rajesh Chourey, DGM & CDO praised the efforts of SBIPA(K) in resolving the pensioners issues on a day to day basis. He also expressed that his office door is always open for our retiree Pensioners. He also appreciated the enthusiasm of our office bearers in conducting such a huge gathered AGM. He also made an appeal to all to help in improving the business portfolio of the circle in particular and Bank as a whole to retain the Number one position.

Shri Dipak Kumar Basu, G.S FSBIPA congratulated the team of SBIPA(K), and thanked for inviting him as Chief Guest and conveyed his greetings to all the members on behalf of the federation. In his speech he briefed about the following issues.

1. Latest development with regards to court case.
2. Inclusion of disabled children as a dependant family members.
3. 40:50 issue payment of arrears from the date of retirement.
4. Inclusion of PQP/FPA for the 7th BPS. Retirees etc.

He also spoke as to why our Federation is joining hands with CBPRO which is a collective body of all Banks pensioners /retirees association .

Shri M. Ravikumar G.S. SBSU(K) conveyed his greetings to all the members on behalf of the 8000+members of SBSU(K) in Bangalore circle. He recalled his sweet memories of some of the senior members with whom he had associated and conveyed his salutations to all of them. He also reiterated that the issues of the pensioners, whatever it may be will be escalated to AISBISF & NCBE regularly and assured all help to SBIPA(K) from time to time.

Shri Parshuram, DGS(HQ), SEWA extended his greetings on behalf of SEWA. He also recollected his old memories of having worked with some senior members who were present in the meeting and assured full cooperation to SBIPA(K).

Shri M.G. Venkatesha Murthy, Sr.Vice President of FSBIPA while addressing appealed to all the members to take active part in the Association. He also thanked the Bank Executives and G.S. FSBIPA for sparing their valuable time.

In the midst of the meeting Shri D.B. Phatak, who is one of our Senior Member donated a sum of Rs.15,000 to our Association as being done by him continuously as a gesture of love and affection to the Organisation. The Association also honoured him on this occasion along with Shri Apsingekar, Shri N.P. Madaiah who crossed the age of 90 as on 31/12/2024. All the dignitaries on the Dias joined their hands in honoring them.

The Inaugural function concluded with Vote of Thanks by the General Secretary Shri. A.L. Ramaswamy Rao to the Management Executives, General Secretary of Federation, General Secretary SBSU(K), DGS(HQ) SEWA, all the members and their families, all volunteers for their wholehearted support in conducting the AGM successfully. He also thanked the Team of R.V. Aster Hospitals, Indira Food Products, KITE, Catering team, and

Sound system team. He along with Smt. Renuka Desai appealed to all members to take active participation in the Business sessions after the lunch break. A small cultural programe was arranged by Shri Prasad and their Team during the lunch break.

## **BUSINESS SESSION**

Business session commenced exactly at 3.00 PM with a huge gathering of more than 300 members. The President called the meeting to order and requested the members to be attentive and take active part in the deliberations. All the MC members were on the Dias to witness the deliberations. The President then requested the General Secretary to take up the Agenda one by one as per notice sent to the members.

Minutes of the 39th GB Meeting held on 18/12/2023 was placed to the house and adopted unanimously, proposed by Shri Ranganath and seconded by shri Anandmurthy.

Shri A.L.Ramaswamy Rao then read out the G.S. Report in detail which was unanimously adopted by the house. The adoption was proposed by Shri B.Ravindra Pai and was seconded by shri K.N.N.Prasad.

Audited Financial Statement for the financial year ending 31/03/2024 was presented to the house. During discussions on the same few members expressed their views about increase in printing expenses in general and Pensioners musings in particular. President Shri Ramesh Rao explained in detail about the financial position of our association. He touched upon the collection of yearly subscription, decline in enrolment of new members on account of decrease in retirement, printing cost, and demating of physical shares held by the association. After due deliberations house adopted the same which was proposed by Shri B.S.Manohar and seconded by Shri A.V. Rajan. It was also approved by the house to continue M/S.Ganesh and Company as auditors for the year 2025-2026.

The agenda of amendment to byelaws of the association as proposed by the Managing Committee was moved in the house for approval. General Secretary Shri A.L.Ramaswamy Rao and President Shri T. Ramesh Rao explained to the house as to the need for the same.

After threadbare discussions on some of the Bye laws which needed small corrections (eg. Byelaw no.14) it was approved by the house proposed by Shri B.S.Manohar and seconded by Shri Satish Deshpande.

During Members time Sarvashri Anandmurthy, Shri Ranganath, Shri Srinivas, Shri M.K. Subramanya, Shri Narayana Misri, Shri S.A.Pawar, Shri Vijayakumar K, Shri B.S. Manohar, Shri P.K. Nandyalkar, Sri. M.Y. Kumar, Shri T.D. Naik, Shri Satish Deshpande, and Shri B.K. Angadi spoke on various issues concerning Pensioners and gave suggestions to the association. The Chair assured the members that within the limitations, the suggestions will be looked into.

The Few suggestion by the members are as under.

1. To curtail printing/postal expenses.
2. To send soft copies of the musings through E-mail.
3. To supply yearly dairies to all the members at cost.
4. To demand Payment of Insurance Premium by the Bank.
5. To Demand reimbursement of OPD expenses from Insurance company.
6. To hold AGM of the Association in places other than Headquarters.
7. To demand more stock of medicines at dispensaries.
8. To demand Deepavali gifts to pensioners.
9. To review/Reduce Hospitalization charges.

Some of the important resolutions/Suggestions moved by the managing committee were accepted in one voice by the house. The suggestions were as under.

- a) To request all the members upto membership No.1891 to pay a sum of Rs.1000 as one time measure and regularize their membership (already approved in AGM dated 18/12/2023).
- b) To request all the members from membership no.1892 to 3616 enrolled upto 31/12/2016 to pay 50% of the annual subscription due, subject to a maximum of Rs.4,000 as one time measure. This was moved to ensure that all those members who are in substantial arrears of membership subscription outstanding to be out of the purview of Bye law No. 25(a) by making the above payment.
- c) To make a request to all the members who are yet to pay the Donation amount on account of increase in pension with regard to 40:50 Anomaly, and Exgratia amount received on account of 12th BPS/9th Joint note, and payment of arrears on account of wage revision for members retired upto 31/05/2024.

Shri M.Y. Kumar presented a photograph of Shri Brahmanandam, founder President of our Association to the Association.

Shri Dinesh who made all the arrangement including catering, Shri Sridhar from Anand rathi, Shri Srinivas and Shri Govindraaj from Mediassist were honoured for their service and help to our pensioners.

Finally Vote of Thanks was proposed by Shri Shankar N. Naik, Vice President of our Association, conveying thanks to all the persons who were behind the successful conduct of the AGM.

The Meeting ended with National Anthem.

## **REPORT OF THE GOVERNING BODY MEETING OF FEDERATION OF SBI PENSIONERS ASSOCIATIONS HELD AT SBILD PANCHAKULA ON 09/03/2025.**

The Governing Body of the Federation of SBI Pensioners Associations was held on 09/03/2025 hosted by the Pensioners Association Chandigarh Circle led By Shri Mohinder Virmani, General Secretary and Shri Vijay Magon President of SBIPA Chandigarh Circle . The Inauguration of the Meeting commenced at 10.30 A.M by lighting of lamp by Shri Kajal Kumar Bhowmick, DGM & CDO of Chandigarh Circle, Smt. Anita Hira AGM PPG Chandigarh Circle, Shri Sanjay Sharma General Secretary, SBIOA Chandigarh Circle, Shri Amit Bansal, CM PPG Chandigarh Circle, Shri G.K.Gandhi President FSBIPA., Shri Dipak Kumar Basu, General Secretary FSBIPA, Shri Mohinder Virmani General Secretary of the Host Circle and Shri Vijay Magon President of the Host Circle. The Management Functionaries present at the Inauguration praised the efforts taken by the Pensioners Association in different circle represented by our Federation in sorting out the problems faced by our pensioners and assured that the Bank will put every effort to mitigate the issues of the pensioners.

The meeting conduced with heavy heart the deaths of members who died since last meeting & observed one minute silence.

After the Inauguration the Governing body meeting commenced at 12.30 P.M. Shri Dipak Kumar Basu, General Secretary, FSBIPA read out the Agenda which was already circulated amongst the affiliate members.

Minutes of the Governing Body Meeting held on 24/09/2024 at Pune was adopted after some changes suggested by Shri D.Krishna Kumar, Vice President Hyderabad circle regarding new stagnation increment to eligible Scale IV officers under 7<sup>th</sup> Joint Note and stagnation increment to eligible Scale V officers under 8<sup>th</sup> Joint Note and include the same which was missing in the minutes. Shri Joseph Palackan from Kerala circle raised an issue of pension option to erstwhile Associate Bank resignees which was also raised in last Meeting held in Pune was also to be included in the minutes.

Shri Basu also announced that the Federation had received Rs.3.00 lacs from Bhopal Circle, Rs.1.00 lacs

from Chandigarh Circle, Rs.3,46,200.00 from Jaipur Circle all totalling to Rs.76,69,500.00 lacs and asked all the members to update page No.22 and 21 in the report circulated by the Federation. Correction was also suggested in Page No.6,7,8,10,11,13, and page Report. Issues pending with the Bank was read out mentioned in page No.9,10, and 11.) Mention was also made about the Court Case no.1875/2013 in the report and made it clear about the amended application along with the original application which has been accepted by the Honorable Court.

Relationship with the serving employees organizations was also mentioned wherein it was decided that all the three organizations will join together to fight out any onslaught from the Bank Management or the Government.

Mention was also made about joining hand with CBPRO and to fight along with them for some of our common issues like Pension Updation, improvement in family pension, restoration of commutation after 10 years instead of the present 15 years, improvement in commutation factor etc. mention was also made regard the meeting with IBA officials by a delegation consisting of leaders of FSBIPA, AIBPARC, FORBE, AIBRAF on 23<sup>rd</sup> January and requested them to make an early resolution of all the long pending demands.

Mention was also made regarding the improvements in Policy B and raising of limits for Angioplasty, Root Canal treatment, Hernia, Knee replacement, Prostate and also expressed unhappiness as the percentage of pensioners opting for policy B was only 41% through out India. (Bangalore Circle stands 6<sup>th</sup> and 97 % of the policies stands renewed). It was also suggested that Insurance premium paid by the Single pensioners should also be paid subsidy as the insurance risk is only for a single person.

As for as Pension from MWS scheme it was appraised that life certificate has not been submitted by the eligible members may be due to lack of knowledge and lack of information. It was requested to share the information with the eligible members.

Shri A.L. Ramaswamy Rao and Shri T. Ramesh Rao raised the matter regarding a letter written by Commune Leaders to Smt. Nirmala Sitharaman, Finance Minister complaining about the non representation of their association at the structured meetings with the State Bank Management and complaining that only FSBIPA is called for the structured meeting. A Point was also made as the Commune (New Name State Bank Retirees Association) are a part of AIRBEA (as mentioned in their letter head) which in turn is a constituent in CBPRO which means members in CBPRO Complaining about their own members. The letter was shared with the President who asked the General Secretary to look into the matter.

Federation General Secretary also mentioned about the problems of Delhi Circle Pensioners Association regarding 2 groups for having elections which was Directed by the court to Register of Societies, South district, Saket New Delhi to get the election of SBI Pensioner's Association as per approved Bye laws and efforts made by our Federation to solve the issue.

The meeting ended with a positive note. Vote of thanks was given by Shri Vijay Magon, President SBIPA Chandigarh Circle.

### **Structured Meeting with Corporate Centre**

Structured Meeting with Corporate center was held on 10/03/2025 at Hotel Hyatt in Chandigarh. The Corporate centre was represented by Shri. Binod Kumar Mishra, DMD (HR) AND CDO, Shri Kishan Sharma, CGM Chandigarh Circle, Shri Rajeevkumar CGM (HR), Shri Sourav Ghosh, DGM P&PPMG, Shri Kajal Kumar Bhowmick DGM CDO, Smt. Anita Hira, AGM PPG, Shri Amitav Kumar AGM(IR). Shri Dipankar Mishra (GM P&PM). The Federation was represented by President, Shri G.K.Gandhi, Shri Dipak Basu, General Secretary and 2 members from respective Circle Pensioners Association. Earlier in the morning representative from e-pharmacy vendors namely, U.R.Life, Medibuddy and Tata 1MG put across their services provided to our pensioners and also listened to the grievances expressed by our members mainly orders being cancelled after confirmation, unavailability of some medicines in this scheme which was available in their own stores, non supply of vitamin tablets etc. Representatives from SBI General insurance also attended who were told about the

rejection of bills which was a cause of serious concern and one of the reasons for pensioners in renewing the policy.

In the afternoon after lunch every body reassembled in the hall CGM Shri Kishan Sharma welcomed the gathering. All the representatives from each Circle were honoured by DMD(HR)&CDO, CGM Chandigarh Circle & CGM(HR) personally which was a nice gesture on the part of the corporate centre/Chandigarh Circle.

Shri Rajeev Kumar CGM(HR) spoke and recalled the structured meeting held at INDORE about 15 months back. He also reminded about the Samadhan Pakhwada which was announced at Ahmedabad AGM of Fedration and expressed his dissatisfaction as that has become a platform for Non Pension issues. He was of the opinion that the name of Samadhan Pakhwada should be renamed. He also touched about the improvement in the Insurance policy, portal for applying on behalf of pensioners, inclusion of check up in E pharmacy scheme, 80% subsidy to pensioners aged above 80years. He also requested the Pensioners Federation to guide the Management wherever possible.

Shri G.K.Gandhi, President FSBIPA spoke about the effects of Murmu Committee Report, difference in commutation factor between SBI and other Banks, delay in inclusion of Handicapped Children as Family Pension beneficiary and requested the management to look into the matter. He also recalled that previously hearing Aid was permitted to be purchased (1% of REMBS) from REMBS which was not so now, and requested the Corporate Centre to relook into it. He also called upon the management to look into the problems in Dispensaries like posting of permanent doctors and the reason for the non availability of doctors due to meager compensation being paid to them, shortage of qualified pharmacist, and problems of pensioners in small places who are deprived of the above facilities. He also reminded about the errors in HRMS data especially spouse name, sex, age, non approval of photos or life certificates at branch level causing anxiety amongst the pensioners. Non approval of photos in HRMS at branch level does not permit the pensioner to download identity cards and also unable to submit life certificate through online methods. He also expressed his unhappiness as pensioners are not receiving support at Branch level.

Shri Dipak Basu General Secretary told about the non circulation of the last structured meeting minutes and also mentioned that the agenda for both the meeting was same. And expressed satisfaction that atleast one structured meeting is being conducted once in a year, and requested for at least meeting twice in a year. He thanked the Corporate Centre for the initiative taken and hoped that it would continue.

Shri Binod Kumar Mishra, DMD(HR) and CDO, welcomed the gathering . He expressed that last year Bank had a profit of Rs.61,000 crores and expected this year to be 70,000 crores. He also expressed his anguish that the growth had slowed down, and CASA deposits has to be improved. He requested the Association to be brand Ambassadors and help in mobilising more deposits so that CASA could be improved. He expressed satisfaction that SBI is the most trusted Bank in the world and make it to the top 10 Banks in the world. He informed that 2.87 lacs retirees are being paid pension out of 3.19 lacs retirees, and expressed regret that there was a delay in conducting structured meetings. He also assured to take care of the digitization of EMW scheme.

Shri Rajeev Kumar, CGM (HR) Corporate centre proposed to Shri G.K. Gandhi to form a 5 member

committee to discuss and resolve issues every Quarter at the corporate centre level. He also emphasized about the digitization of MWS AND PPA records so that PPA with correct entries could be made available.

Shri Rajkumar Chabria, Secretary FSBIPA spoke and informed that in the new HRMS data was incorrect in many cases, while transferring data from old HRMS to New HRMS, and both old and new HRMS Portal was opening causing lot of confusion amongst pensioners while uploading personal data to which CGM HR told that w.e.f. 01/04/2025 old HRMS will not work. Shri Chabria also insisted on providing a separate product code for staff pensioners to avoid the system debiting charges or pre payment of Pension loans. It was also brought to the notice that the minimum amount to be Wealth Customer for General Public is Rs. 50.00 Lacs and the same yardstick is being applied to Staff and retirees also and requested to reconsider and revert back to the old limit of Rs.30 Lacs. Executives from CC also expressed that for purchasing of medicines for dispensaries, budget should not be an issue.

The meeting ended with Vote of thanks by Shri Saurav Gosh DGM (PPMD).

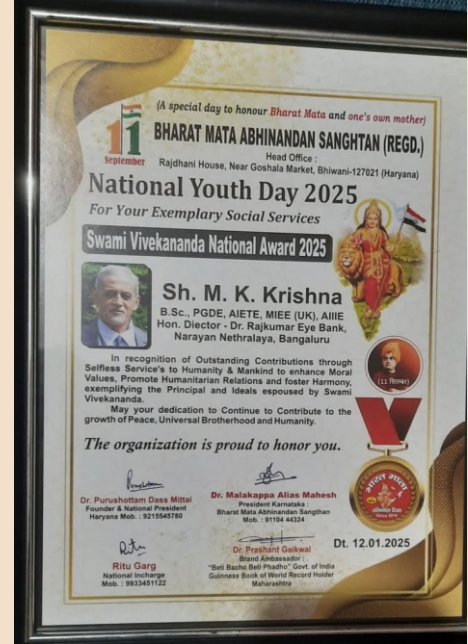
